>> Dear Dr. Cricelli !

>>

>> The Austrian delegation welcomes the proposals on amendments of the  
> UEMO-Statutes made by the Danish and the U.K. delegation. We substantially  
> approve the content of the submitted documents UEMO 99/018 and the Danish  
> paper of June 11th, 1999.

>>

>> In addition we would like to introduce the following suggestions:

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>> Parting from the procedure of confirming the presidency considerations  
> should aim at establishing provisions in the statutes, making it possible  
> in exceptional situations to withdraw confidence from the president in  
> term. Any withdrawal of confidence, however, should be conditional on a  
> decision taken by a two-thirds or three-quarters majority.

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>> In this case as well as in the case of a presidency failing to obtain  
> confirmation by the plenum, we suggest that the proposed Executive  
Steering

> Committee shall be in charge. The present national secretariat, which is  
in

> charge at this time, should continue to conduct UEMO relevant duties until  
> election of a new president and will be considered as dissolved after the  
> constitution of the new presidency.

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>> What we further consider necessary is a discussion on implementing  
> provisions aiming at economizing the UEMO budget.

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>> Referring to the document UEMO 99/025 of the German delegation, we fully  
> endorse the amendments concerning the working method of the UEMO working  
> groups. We also advocate the creation of a UEMO documentation center.

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>> Kindly asking you to provide all other delegations with this document we  
> remain
