1. Does your undergraduate medical curriculum include specific lectures on preventive activities in general practice? **YES**
2. Does your vocational training include lectures on preventive activities in general practice? **YES**
3. Do your CME programs give enough importance to preventive activities topics? **YES**
4. Does the Primary Health Care System in your country include structured program on primary preventive activities? **YES**
5. Are general practitioners involved in national programs concerning primary preventive activities? **YES**
6. Do GPs participate in national primary preventive programs on a voluntary basis? **YES**
7. Do GPs participate in national primary preventive activities programs as an integral part of their duties? **YES**
8. Do GPs get paid specifically for carrying out preventive activities? **Generally not but there are a few exceptions (e.g. pap smears)**
9. Is your organization involved in preventive activities as a strategy? **YES**
10. Is your organization involved in any specific project concerning preventive activities? **YES**
11. Should UEMO undertake to develop a policy concerning general practice and preventive activities? **Not directly. In our opinion UEMO should focus on medico-political aspects and should rather encourage Governments and Medical Associations to allocate resources to preventive activities so that set standards and academic guidelines can be adopted in a professional way.**
