How do I find the information I'm used to?

You can navigate the site three different ways - by subject category ,by “direct jump” from homepage and by searching the information with the internal search engine. The subjects are listed in the left-hand navigation bar.

What are the subjects in the left nav bar?

With each subject category, you will find all the information UEMO has to offer about that subject. Subject categories are hierarchical, similar to standard file directories or Usenet groups. The deeper you drill down, the more specific the information will be. Unlike a standard file directory structure, the higher-level categories contain all the information from the subcategories. The higher up in the navigation, the more general the collection of information becomes. When you click on those links, you will notice the left-hand nav bar changes to list the new subjects.

What are the Types in the horizontal gray bar?

Types are different kinds of information within each subject. For example, subject categories may contain feature articles, tutorials, directory listings, software downloads, code, vendor listings, and certifications. When you click on a type link, you will see a list of that type of information within the subject.

Why do I see the same information in different areas?

You may notice that certain information appears in more than one place on the site. Each piece of information may cover multiple subjects and be valuable to different audiences. Now we give access to the same piece of information from various subject categories or sites, ensuring that you never miss valuable pieces of data. Also, notice that each piece of information in a lower-level subject category will appear in a higher-level subject category. While we don't want it to take too long to find a piece of information, our subject navigation allows you to find very specific information in areas with large quantities of files.

The new UEMO site tries to:

1. delivers content effectively

2. is easy to use and maintain
3. has a robust architecture
4. uses technology appropriately

What are the new features of the site?

Besides the navigational changes, there are several new features on the site.

1. Printer-friendly pages

Based on the number of requests we received, everyone appears to want pages that print clearly. Each resource page now has a printer-friendly version. Just click where you see this image.

2. Improved search

We spent months cataloging all of our information so it takes less time for you to find it. This work has resulted in more accurate search functionality. If you can't find the information you are looking for by browsing, our search will help you find it.

3. A completely redesigned Members Area.

It includes now all the minutes, the questionnaires, the working groups reports, the general agendas, members addresses, the statute and the official documents of UEMO.

What new features will be added in the future?

Our new platform will enable us to constantly add new features and functionality. Expect to see these features added in the coming months:

- Member profiles that you can update and browse
- A new message boards and several discussion forums
- Site customization, delivering the information you specifically request.
