5. From 1995 all general practitioners must follow the specialty of Family and Community Medicine. From 1978 to 1995 general practitioners without a specialty diploma could obtain it by means of diverse summons in order to obtain the specialisation or the “certificación de derechos adquiridos”(certification of acquired rights), to practise as such.

 - The specialist in Family and Community Medicine follows a 3 years residency programme (MIR) and has a specialist degree.
 - There is no recertification
 - There are no differences as for the independence, the system and level of payment, and the status.
