#### **German training scheme for General Practitioners within a Training period of 5 years, last update 11.06.1999**

The following text concerns Niedersachsen.  
There might be slight deviations in other Länder

#### General Practice

- 1 The following number of cases and further training contents (examination procedures and treatment procedures) need to be proven:
  - 100 independently conducted and documented cases of consultation in general practice, diagnostics and therapy concepts within the framework of health disorders occurring in general practice within a non-selected patient group, including such cases with the necessity of coordinating the therapy concepts with specialists and their diagnostics, therapy and rehabilitation as well as compiling, evaluating and storing the findings, including 20 cases of independently conducted and documented cases of a treatment and care concept for chronically ill, multi-morbid and dying patients
  - 50 independently conducted and documented cases of health consultation in general practice, of early recognition of health disorders, including prevention of health damaging ways of life and behaviour
  - 50 independently conducted and documented cases of disease prevention with the help of vaccination measures against frequently occurring infectious diseases

- 20 independently conducted or co-treated and documented cases of diagnostics, differential diagnostics and treatment of health disorders, caused by the environment or the job
- 50 independently documented cases of physiotherapy
- 100 independently documented cases of diagnostics, differential diagnostics, therapy and possibly rehabilitation of geriatric health disorders or diseases
- 50 independently documented cases of diagnostics, differential diagnostics, therapy of health disorders or diseases in children
- 50 independently documented cases of diagnostics, differential diagnostics, therapy and possibly rehabilitation of mental, psychosomatic and/or somato-psychic symptoms, health disorders or diseases
- 30 continuous Balint group hours, including a presentation of three cases
- collaborating on and documenting of 25 cases of diagnostics and therapy in emergency medicine, in particular of lifesaving measures for maintaining the vital functions (eg keeping open the respiratory pathways, control of bleeding, shock treatment)
- 60 hours of participation in organised emergency and on-call duties
- conducting and evaluating independently 500 electrocardiograms, including 100 with a defined effort
- conducting and evaluating independently long-term blood pressure measurements in 50 patients
- conducting and evaluating independently 50 proctoscopies
- conducting and evaluating independently 50 rectoscopies
- conducting and evaluating independently 100 spirometric examinations with the help of simple apparatus
- 200 Doppler ultrasound examinations of the vessels supplying the extremities, including 100 on arteries and 100 on veins in health disorders and diseases seen in general practice
- 50 independently conducted and documented cases of diagnostics, differential diagnostics and treatment of injuries typically to be found in general practice, of incision, extirpation, extraction and sample excision, also using local and peripheral conduction block anaesthesia, including 25 cases of initial treatment of people injured in an accident, including the organisation of further specialist treatment as well as the organisation of transportation

- 100 independently conducted and documented cases of diagnostics, differential diagnostics and treatment of patients suffering from pain that have not reached the stage of a disease of their own yet, typically to be found in general practice
  - arriving at an indication, proper sample-taking and -treating for laboratory tests as well as evaluating and allocating the results to the respective disease as well as methods for and execution of laboratory diagnostics close to the patient, this includes:
    - erythrocyte (blood) sedimentation rate, ESR, BSR
    - immunology or biochemical examination of a body material with pre-fabricated test carriers and test preparations with a visual or apparatus evaluation (eg cholesterol, glucose, haemoglobin, HbA1<sub>c</sub>, Helicobacter pylori-Test, troponin)
    - cultural bacteriological tests with the help of a pre-fabricated culture medium, including a possible inhibitor test
    - leukocyte counting (eg counting cell chamber method)
    - microscopic examination of a native preparation
    - microscopic examination for simple colouring (eg methylene blue test)
    - test for blood in stool
    - urine analysis with test strip
    - urine sediment
    - streptococcus A short-term test
    - pregnancy test
- 2 Participation in courses of altogether 80 hours duration according to the recommendations on the design of the contents and time of such courses laid down in the (Model) Vocastional Training Rules.
