At the last meeting, it was agreed to send out a new questionnaire on CME/CPD. With the preparation of the last questionnaire (2002/042) considerable time was used to formulate the questions. The final paper (UEMO 01/092) included a wish to reissue the questionnaire later for comparative purposes. Therefore it is important to repeat the same questions. The purpose of the questionnaire is to clarify possible development in the area and to act as an inspiration for the delegations. It must be emphasized that the responses to the last questionnaire highlighted the following:

A tendency towards mandatory CME and possibly also recertification was mentioned in the responses. There was a vague manifestation concerning accreditation as well as that financing of CME seemed to depend on very different models.

On this background, a slightly amended survey could be produced, where the question about accreditation and financing could perhaps be specified/revised in

the light of the discussion on the following items and with a view to clarifying this area.

- 4. Accreditation: (UEMO 2002/150 - Danish example of accreditation of the CME provider) (UEMO 2002/068 and 2002/151- UEMS project - concrete accreditation of CME courses).**

With a view to getting further into this area a discussion is planned concerning UEMO's role in it. This discussion must, among others, be seen on the basis of the discussion on the proposal for a directive on postgraduate training in which CME will presumably play a more significant role in the future. A UEMO model like the one UEMS has or a cooperation with the UEMS on EACCME is still under consideration as earlier discussed in the working group.

- 5. Financing of CME (CPME 2002/094 and CPME 2003/021)**

With reference to item 3 concerning the outcome of the questionnaire two years ago, a discussion of the different European models for financing CME is desirable, but also clarify the questions in the planned new survey.
